

Section 2 had 3 coding questions where 1st one was easy, 2nd one was average and 3rd one was difficult.

Technical Round 1

They started this one with basics questions like oops concept, Inline functions, Friend function, Scope operator, Multiple inheritance (How is it different in JAVA), Virtual Keyword, Abstract Class, STL Library, Data structures (Basics questions on linked list, Queue, Stack, Tree) Also some conceptual questions based on queue & Stack.

They had given me 2 codes and said me to reduce the time and space complexities. A verbal projects discussion.
